

Feeding Chicago's Unhoused Residents

129
Care Bags
Distributed

In 2023, Worldlight gave a total of 129 Care Bags to Chicago's homeless; specifically in the Chinatown, Uptown, and Hyde Park neighborhoods. Care Bags contained a tract with a gospel message, a copy of the New Testament's Book of John, water, and food items such as chips and a granola bar. The recent migrant crisis in chicago also created an increased need for the gospel to be preached.







The team held a special Thanksgiving Outreach Event, where 61 Care Bags were distributed to the homeless. Residents heard the message of the gospel of Jesus Christ and were encouraged to accept Him as their personal Savior.

Evangelism at the Chicago Pride Parade & Steps of Faith Evangelism

In 2023, Worldlight volunteers embarked on a new venture, spreading the light of Jesus at the pride parade. The goal was that even if one person would look at the sign, or hear the words, "Jesus Loves You", they would turn and repent and be saved. The participants of the Chicago Pride Parade had varied reactions to this. The evangelism session on that day was impactful and fruitful. Worldlight's strategy was to convey the message of Jesus' love, while holding a sign that read "Real Love = Jesus Died to set us free from sin and Give us eternal life". This approach elicited a range of responses. Some responded with insults. Others offered a simple "God bless you", and some engaged the volunteers in debates. The day was deemed a success as it achieved its objective: to communicate to people that Jesus loves them and that He sacrificed Himself to redeem them from their sins.



Other Evangelism sessions took place as a part of the Step's of Faith Challenges.

Our strategy was to convey the message of Jesus' love.

STEPS OF FAITH

The new "Steps of Faith" program encourages healthy living from a Christian perspective and incorporates evidence-based approaches to spiritual, physical, mental and emotional fitness across all ages.

In 2023, Worldlight engaged the community and encourganged healthy living through three unique challenges in 2023. Challenges were designed to address a specific area of health, both spiritual and physical. Each challenged was promoted on social media networks to encourage involvement. During the challenge, the Steps' team published content aimed at encouraging continual involvement and increasing participation. Each advertisement was monitored to track engagement.



STEPS OF FAITH

The Evangelism and Exercise challenge received both "positive" and "negative" forms of engagement. The social media ads for this challenge garnered 34 of negative comments, suggesting some level of disapproval of the ads. This may be due to the religious nature of the challenge.

The Water and Word challenge garnered a high number of likes and shares, indicating strong engagement and interest. The lack of positive comments is due to the lack of direct interaction on the social media posts. Similar to the Evangelism and Exercise challenge, there were negative and non-related comments on the social media ads. The reason for this is unclear.

The Daniel Plant-Based challenge received the lowest engagement among the three, with fewer positive reactions and shares compared to the previous challenges. The absence of challenge-related comments indicates a possible need to increase advertisement. The lower number of negative reactions and non-related comments may suggest that the challenge was less controversial as compared to the previous challenges. This could also be due to the fact that this challenge was shorter in duration than previous challenges.

Overall engagement was deemed generally positive, with a significant number of "likes" and "shares" across all challenges. Negative reactions such as in the form of angry emojis and negative comments, were present in varying degrees, possibly due to the religious nature of the challenges. Future challenges will be aimed at increasing in-person engagement.

The Salvation Journey Docuseries was envisioned in 2019 and birthed in 2022. The aim is to help individuals evangelize by sharing their salvation story. We serve them by creating an interview-documentary of their story. in 2023, the multimedia team recorded Pastor Titus' story believing that this would help many people to realize God's writing in their own live. We believe that every Christian has a journey about how God brought them out of the darkness and into the light and each of our testimonies holds the power to defeat the works of the enemy.

WEEKLY SCRIPTURAL POSTS

Worldlight believes in the power of the scripture to comfort and encourage. The Spirit of Truth, who works in the Word of God is able to bring hope and the light of God into the lives of all. Each week, we post a few verses of scripture as we are led. The 60-second format of the Youtube Shorts, Instagram & Facebook Reels and Stories increases the likelihood of engagement by placing the scripture in a more appealing format. A total of 44 scriptures were posted.

Worldlight's TOK exists to develop the gifts of men, women, and children in order for them to serve in the Kingdom of God. The program aims to combine "Show and Tell" with the biblical mandate to "Go and tell" (Mark 16:15). In short, Worldlight's Talents of the Kingdom is evangelism through talent development and mastery.



Worldlight True Worshippers held a month-long music session at Pui Tak Christian School. This wasn't just a music session; it was a learning experience about worshipping God in Spirit and in Truth. Members of True Worshippers taught 5th-10th graders in an after school session and witnessed their growth in understanding true worship and praise. Children sang worship and praise songs while learning practical lessons about worshipping God with music.

WORLDLIGHT KIDS




